OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS.

1. Initial Input programmes, cards 0 - 18.
2. Switch scope to D.L.7, which displays the title "Willie the Worm", and line up with the row of ones at the bottom.
3. Switch scope to D.L.4.
4. Set and leave a number, preferably between P25 and P32, on the I.D.: the larger this number is the faster the movement of the "worm" about the scope. The speed of movement can be altered during operation by altering the number on the I.D.

NOTE: While the I.D. is zero the programme goes round a three instruction loop.
